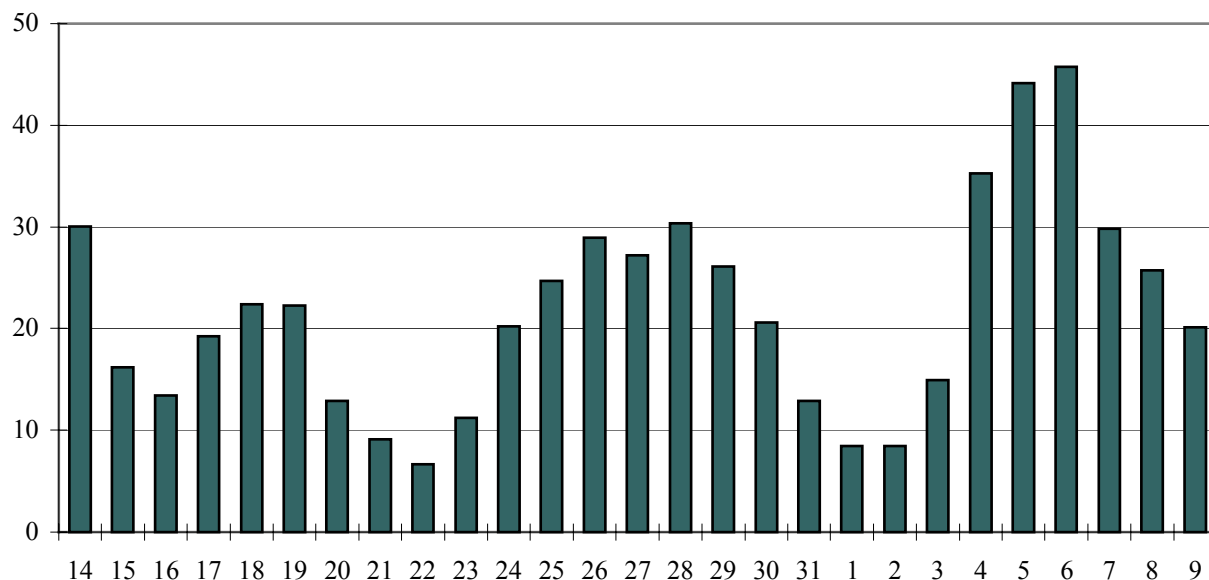

We spent a very nice one and a half weeks in Lemmenjoki, lots of listening and also a lot of antenna experiments and improvements in the antenna park. E.g. the very successful antenna in 30 degrees towards Oceania was erected and showed its capability the next two weeks after we had left the scene. Conditions were average but every day something interesting was heard. Every day provided several hours of silence in the MW-band in the middle of the day that gave us plenty of time doing something else than just listening and the weather was fine for outdoor activities.

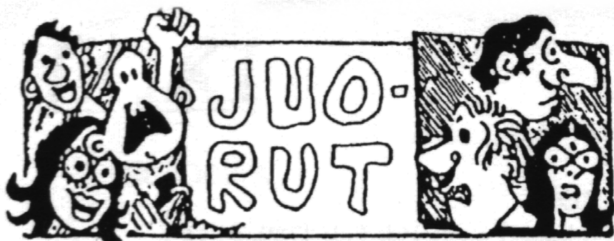

CROATIA

Croatian Radio - unknown transmitter on 1143 kHz. Croatian Radio - The Voice of Croatia (incl. HR 1) can be heard on a new frequency of 1143 kHz. The signal is quite strong in my location. I can hear all other croatian (HR) MW transmitters but Osijek (= Osijek) 594 kHz. Is it because of a strong German transmitter on this frequency or because Osijek was retuned to 1143 kHz?

Osijek should have only 10 kW on 594 kHz (see WRTH 2005, p. 506), but the transmitter

on 1143 kHz seems to be stronger. No change mentioned on the HR web <www.hrt.hr> no response yet to my e- mail sent to their technical department ... (Karel Honzik-CZE, mwdx Oct 10)

The Croatian transmitter network operator OIV confirmed that the transmitter in Osijek on 594 (HR Glas Hrvatske) was moved to 1143 kHz. The power is 10 kW. OIV is planning to perform DRM tests on 594 towards the end of this year. (Bernd Trutenau-LTU, mwdx Oct 10)

DENMARK

No, I don't think there's a chance that DR or Denmark would give up 243 even though transmissions on 243 kHz are likely to be suspended as of Dec 31 2006. Plans are that the transmitters will be kept in place ready to be taken into use should it be necessary in an emergency situation or whenever DRM should become relevant.

I am one of the 10 members of the board of DR and I was the only one to vote against the closure of the MW and LW transmitters in Kalundborg. Following the board meeting (where the decision was taken) I suggested replacing the LW/MW transmissions with SW transmissions of a few newscasts to serve Danes abroad (incl. fishermen at sea) but this was (of course) also turned down.

FRANCE

Paris Live Radio to launch trial mediumwave service.

Christian Ghibaudo drew our attention to the following: on 4 October, the French Conseil supérieur de l'audiovisuel (CSA) authorised a 3 month trial licence to Paris Live Radio for broadcasts on mediumwave 963 kHz in the Paris area. Paris Live Radio broadcasts to the English-speaking community in France. It currently operates across France on Canal Satellite, across Paris and Ile de France on digital cable, DAB and the Internet. 963 kHz was used by Radio Sorbonne until 1997 from the Romainville transmitter site near Paris with a power of 8 kW, but the frequency is currently unused. According to Bernd Trutenau on mwdx mailing list, the station started on August 31 and has a transmitter power of 0.1 kW. Local programmes are carried at 0600-0700, 1000-1100 and 1500-1600 UTC, while at other times the station relays Polskie Radio 3 ("Trójka"). BHUTAN: On checking at 0058 UT hear tone modulated opening carrier on 6035. 0100 s.on procedure. So it is very much on SW. Signals fair but by 0130 UT fade out here near the equator. Will get stronger as the sun goes down

to the Southern Hemisphere. Cant hear it around 1200-1400 UT, too much QRM. (Victor Goonetilleke-CLN 4S7VK DXplorer Oct 2 via Topnews)

CHINA: CRI launches Newsradio on 900 kHz AM China Radio International (CRI) has launched CRI Newsradio in the capital Beijing on 900 kHz AM and 90.5 MHz FM. According to Xinhua news agency, the new channel began broadcasting on September 28. CRI Newsradio provides a 24-hour service of news, current affairs, finance, sports and entertainment programs in Chinese and in foreign languages. Established in 1941, CRI is China's

international radio broadcaster transmitting radio programs in 43 languages. (Dxing.info Oct 2)

GEORGIA: 9535, Abkhaz R (Absua Radio), 2nd outlet on 9535 (probably 9534.8?) is on the air only mornings when the programme is from Sukhum, Mo-Fr 0400-0500 and 0700-0810. Both 9495 and 9535 are typical ex-Soviet jammers with odd x.8 kHz setting. (Pankov in BC-DX, Oct. DXW)

INDONESIA: RRI Palu has been drifting around 3945-3955 range. Very unstable transmitter. (Various sources Sep/Oct) So, the RRI station reported in RM 8/2005 as RRI Dnpasar on 3945 was in fact Palu. (JSA)

JAPAN; NHK has terminated its domestic SW relays. According to NHK Engineering HQ, it was decided in March and they were actually terminated by the end of May. NHK had been using the relays for almost 60 years, but satellite links and quality land lines are more reliable

and convenient these days. Terminated relays are: Sapporo, 600 watts DSB on 3970, 6005 & 9535; Tokyo, 900 watts SSB on 3607.5, 6175 & 9550; Nagoya, 300 watts SSB on 3970, 6005 & 9535; Osaka, 300 watts SSB on 3373.75, 5428 & 9181; and Fukuoka, 300 watts SSB on 3259, 6130 & 9535. (Toshi Ohtake, Japan, JSWC via REVIEW OF THE DX PRESS/DXplorer via Ron Howard, CA, dxldyg via DXLD)

JAPAN: 9760, Nikkei R, Nagara, 2300, Mo Sep 26, Japanese. Seems to be on the air also on other days, not just weekends. (Ritola via DXW)

LAOS: 7145, Lao National Radio. Sept. 24 at 1335-1402*. SINPO 33332. External service in English. News, followed by interview from 1340. News headlines at 1354. National anthem after ID at 1358. Talk in Lao at 1400 and Sign-off at 1402 (Iwao Nagatani, Japan, Japan Premium via DXLD)

LAOS: 4677.88, Lao National Radio, at 1115 to 1130 UT, fading up with some audio, music 21 Sept. ; 20 Sept. same time similar details (Robert Wilkner-FL-USA, DXplorer Sep 25 via BCDX via DXLD)

MALAYSIA: RTM renamed its networks a few months ago, and Radio 4 is now called Traxx FM (yuk!). The other renamed networks on SW are now Nasional FM (ex-Radio 1) in Malay on 5965v; Asyik FM (ex-Radio 7) in Malay & Orasng Asli languages on 6025; Wai FM in Iban/Bidayuh etc. on Kuching 7270; Sarawak FM in Malay on Kuching 5050 & 7130. The Sabah network on 5980v has been renamed as Sabah V FM, but I haven't heard the SW frequency for some time. Regards from Indonesia (Alan Davies via DXplorer via Ron Howard, Sep. DXLD)

PHILIPPINES: AM report Philippines 3 --- Referring to my previous two reports. Here are the full IDs noted for:

1386 DXCR: "Giving praise to our creator and redeemer, this is DXCR 13-86 kHz, Hope Radio, broadcasting from the campus of Mountain View College, Valencia, Biko?. Hope Radio is a member of the KBP". ("Biko" may be a shortening of the province name Bukidnon)

1476 DXVP: "From Zamboanga City on 14-67 kHz, this is DXVP - the radio station of the Roman Catholic Arch Diocese of Zamboanga".

Sunshine Radio: The new Sunshine Radio network carries an announcement listing the following network stations: 819 kHz DWAR Laoag (if call is correct this is ex-DWRI), 1332 DWAY Cabanatuan, 864 DWSI San Fernando (this is listed as Isabela. New network owners could have moved the station to San Fernando, Pampanga province?), 765 DYAR Cebu, 981 DZRD Dagupan, 864 DZSP San Pablo, Laguna, 711 DZYL Ilagan, Isabela, 765 DZYT Tuguegarao, 801 DXBL Bislig, 1098 DXDL Cagayan de Oro (announcement says DXDL, if correct it is a call change from DXCL), 873 DXRB Butuan, 711 DXRD Davao City, 837 DXRE General Santos, 945 DXRO Cotabato, 963 DXYZ Zamboanga and 1404 DXAQ Davao Central (new station).

Most of/all of these stations are listed by the NTC as owned by Nation Broadcasting, so either they have all been sold of by them to the SPM, or this is a renamed network of ex-Angel Radyo stations.

Note that there are two Davao stations, and the announcement underlines that DXAQ is Davao Central. Would be a different location than Davao City then - but what location I could not be sure. Help, anyone? (Geir Stokkeland,

PHILIPPINES: 1179, DYSB Bacolod - RGMA Bacolod was heard 3 September with call-sign DYSB. Has been listed in sources & WRTH-05 with callsign DYCK, and in some listings on 1341 kHz.

1512, DZAT Lucena City - End Time Mission / Pentecostal Missionary Church of Christ 4th Watch (PMCC), 1512 kHz 10 kW in Lucena City, Quezon Province - operating since Oct 2004 acc. to their website.

The Angel Radyo network has been re-branded as Sunshine Radio. It's announcing all the frequencies marked 'an' in WRTH-2005, and additionally DXBL (listed on 801 kHz --- I thought the announcement said 810, but either it or I could be wrong) and new DXAQ Davao City 1404 kHz. DXAQ 1404 is confirmed - I heard it on 3-4 September (Alan Davies, Indonesia? ARC Information Desk Sept 12 via DXLD)

SINGAPORE: Mediacorp has also rebranded their English network relayed on 6150 --- it's now 938LIVE (ex-NewsRadio 93.8). Regards from Indonesia (Alan Davies via DXplorer via Ron Howard, Sep. DXLD)

SRI LANKA: 6005, 9770 and 15747, SLBC, All Asia, having serious trouble. Now only *0025-0400. No evening broadcast. (Goonetilleke)

11905, SLBC Hindi service reintroduced after protests by Indians and request by Indian High Commissioner!! 1530 sign off. (Goonetilleke, Oct 03 via DXW)

TAIWAN: I was really happy to receive a QSL card from The Voice of Han Broadcasting. I had heard the station in April 2004 on 9745. In July I asked R Taiwan International to forward my snail mail letter to the station, because up to then I had got no reply. The result was a nice full data QSL card with English QSL text on one side, Chinese on the other one. AUSTRALIA: A shortwave relay of the ABC domestic service for Perth originates from an Australian Defence Force transmitter in Exmouth, North West Cape, Western Australia. The Department of Defence confirms to DXing.info that recent transmissions heard worldwide on 7875 kHz USB did indeed come from Exmouth. "Defence has been transmitting from this site on an irregular basis since 1994 and was transmitting on 7875 kHz at the time that it was detected," says Communications Adviser Michael Weaver at the Department of Defence in the capital Canberra. "The purpose of the shortwave relay is to provide recreational news for Australian troops overseas. In this case, it was specifically for the Australian rules football grand final," Weaver adds.

Programming on 7875 kHz originated from 6WF Perth (720 kHz), and ABC programming has recently been heard also around 15060 kHz. Steve Napier from the ABC technical staff in Perth says to DXing.info that he is unaware of the shortwave broadcasts.

According to the Register of Radiocommunications Licences of the Australian Communications and Media Authority (ACMA), 7875 kHz has been

allocated to the Department of Defence since 1993. The transmitter in Exmouth has a power of 40 kW.

David Hodgson in the United States was the first to report hearing ABC on 7875 kHz on September 18 in DXLD 5-165. Meanwhile, John Schache in Australia reports on DXing.info that he has heard ABC programming also on "approximately 15060" kHz shortwave. More information about the station can be found in the DXing.info Community. (DXing.info Sep 28) (transmissions not heard anymore on this frequency since around Sep 27 – JSA)

AUSTRALIA: From the ABC website: The ABC would like to advice that it is in the process of upgrading its Alice Springs, Katherine and Tennant Creek shortwave Local Radio services. this work is being undertaken to provide greater reliability of these services. Each service will be required to be switched off for approximately four to six weeks while replacement transmitters are installed. The Tennant Creek transmitter will be the first to be upgraded and will be turned off on Monday 10 October.

NEW CALEDONIA: New Caledonia gets a new station on 729 kHz Radio Nouvelle Caledonie has launched a new mediumwave station on 729 kHz. The transmitter is located in Touho, 350 kilometers northwest from the capital Noumea. According to Australian DXer Chris Martin who contacted TDF in Noumea, the Touho AM station began broadcasting in the second week of September. Patrick Martin in the United States was the first DXer to pick up the station on September 15. Radio Nouvelle

Caledonie also operates an FM station in Touho on 88.0 MHz. (Dxing.info Sep 22)

It was off for couple of days since 16 September due to fault in the exciter power supply, but should be on the air by now. Transmitter is rated 10kW but

runs around 8kW.

The switch-over times from one frequency to another are "about" as there is no remote control system functioning and station's tech has to go to the transmitter site (10km from the town) and manually change frequency and antenna system.
